Curriculum

We use development matters to support our curriculum planning at Tregolls alongside the Early Years Statutory Framework. In Nursery we focus on the three prime areas of learning, Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication and Language and Physical Development.

Our focus this term is getting to know each individual child, ensuring they feel safe and secure and rules and routines.

Attendance

If your child is attending the whole day or morning sessions, please ensure children are in school **by 8:40am**. Nursery enter and exit through the double doors in the EYFS playground. If you are picking up or dropping off during the day (**11:40 - end of morning, 12:10 - start of afternoon**) please use the office entrance. We finish each day at **3:10pm**.

From time to time, there may be exceptional circumstances when your child is too poorly to attend school. If this is the case, please inform the school office by 9am each day of absence.

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School Uniform

Although not compulsory, we advise that our nursery children wear uniform as it helps them to feel part of our school community. More information about what this includes can be found on our website.

Staying Active

PE will take place on Tuesday. As with school uniform we would advise that nursery children wear school PE kit or navy coloured top and shorts with trainers.

Essentials

- Please ensure your child brings a named water bottle to school each day. (These will be sent home daily to wash).
- A pair of named welly boots will be needed in school EVERY day
- A waterproof coat
- Waterproof/puddle suit (Aldi sell good quality/low price ones)
- Spare change of clothes in a named bag – **don't forget spare socks!**
- Nappies and wipes on an individual basis
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From the 25th September we will begin our weekly Fresh Air Friday sessions. Welly boots and waterproofs are essential for these days.

Home Learning

Nursery children will choose a book from our library each week to share with you at home.
