<u>Curriculum</u>

Our new project is called 'Vicious Vikings' with our big question being ''How vicious were the Vikings?'

Although Vikings is the main theme of our topic, the first half term will have an Anglo-Saxon focus to 'set the scene'.

Please see the attached project overview sheet, which contains information about the subject specific curriculum content we will be covering. On the back of the sheet, there are ideas for topic-related learning you could do at home in addition to the children's Home Learning (see below). However, these activities are not compulsory.

Attendance

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PE and Staying Active

Fowey Class PE will take place on a Wednesday and Friday. Children need to wear full, named Tregolls PE kit to school every Wednesday and Friday, including trainers; they may wear warm layers over the top.

Home Learning

Compulsory Home Learning for Key Stage 2 children consists of:

- 20 minutes reading per day (recorded and signed off by an adult in your child's reading planner please send this into school each day)
 - Varied practice of weekly spellings and their definitions on EdShed
 - Practice of weekly times tables on TT Rockstars

Walking Home & Mobile Phones

Now that children are in Year 5, you may wish for them to walk to or from school, or an agreed location off site, alone to promote independence. If this is the case, please ensure myself or the office have this in writing or in an email/Dojo message. Without this, I will not be able to release your child at the end of the day. A separate letter has come home about walking alone permission. A polite reminder that **only children who are walking to or from school alone** should be bringing a mobile phone into school, and only then if they have the permission of their parents/carers and parents/carers have put this in writing. Any mobile phones brought into school must be handed in to the office upon arrival at school where they will be stored securely. Mobile phones will be returned as children leave at the end of the day. Children are not allowed to use mobile phone' policy. Thank you for your support and understanding.
