Head of School Message

Welcome back to the second autumn term. Next week is Anti-Bullying week. This is something that we will not tolerate at Tregolls Academy. We are ensuring that children are kind, caring and respectful to each other. During the week the children will work through a number of activities to look at bullying, what constitutes bullying and the impact this can have on people. This will then be followed up with weekly reminders in our PSHE lessons. To help our children know what bullying is we have developed the acronym: RIP. This stands for Repeated, Intentional and an (imbalance of) Power. The children will be shown the poster below to remind them of this. Our aim is to eradicate bullying so that it does not occur. However, if it does happen, we want adults to proactively deal with it and communicate effectively with parents.

What is 'bullying'?

At Tregolls, we know that bullying is **RIP**:

R

Harmful behaviour is **REPEATED**. It happens again and again over time.

I

Harmful behaviour is **INTENTIONAL**. Someone is deliberately trying to cause physical or emotional harm to someone else.

P

There is an imbalance of **POWER** between the person showing harmful behaviour and the person being harmed.
